When do tickets go on sale?

Tickets are \$110 per couple. 1 ticket = 1 couple

Can we sit with friends at the event?

- Please write the name of the couple(s) you would like to sit with on the event registration form. Please make requests by February 1, 2023.
- Seating will be finalized on February 2, 2023.
 - No seating changes can be made after February 2, 2023.

What if a same-sex couple chooses to attend?

The radio station holds the position that the Biblical definition of marriage is a God-ordained union between a man and a woman (see Mathew 19:4,5). The content of the evening will be based on this understanding. It's possible that a same-sex couple could purchase a registration to the Marriage Celebration. Denying participation is something a religious organization cannot legally do. If this should occur, it's our desire to extend a welcome, accepting them as individuals bearing the image of God and treating them with kindness, while at the same time holding firm in what we stand for as an organization.
